CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT A

PROPOSITION NUMBER 1

Initiative Ordinance - An Ordinance Amending the Kanab City Land Use Ordinance to Require Voter Approval of a Coal Hydro-gasification or Electric Generating Facility

The initiative ordinance amends the Kanab City Land Use Ordinance by requiring a majority of registered voters to approve conditional use permits, expansions of conditional use permits or issuance of any building permits for any coal hydro-gasification or electric generating facilities (facilities producing and/or selling electric energy). Additionally, it retroactively nullifies and voids the prior issuance of any conditional use permit or building permit for such facilities issued prior to a public vote on the permit. Lastly, it requires Kanab City to employ a specially-qualified inspector to inspect all components of such facilities so approved by public vote.
