

PUBLIC NOTICE

Notice is hereby given that on January 1, 2024, the following board positions will be open:

Cedar Mountain Fire Protection District – (3) Three board positions open. Applicants must be a property owner that receive services from the District. Each position will serve a 4-year term.

Church Wells Special Service District – (1) One board position open. Applicants must be a registered voter who owns property within the boundaries of the Church Wells Special Service District, and have been a resident for a minimum of one year. They must have a clear history on water billing. Each applicant's account with CWSSD must also be in good standing. Each position will serve a 4-year term.

East Zion Special Service District – (3) Three board positions open. Applicants must be registered voters of the District, or an officer or employee of the county, or property owners that receive services from the District. Each position will serve a 4-year term.

Kane County Recreation and Transportation Special Service District – (4) Four board positions open. Applicants must be a property owner within Kane County. Each position will serve a 4-year term.

Kane County Water Conservancy District – (4) Four board positions open. Applicants must be a registered voter within the District and will be the director representing one of the following areas: Town of Alton, the Eastern Kane County area, (2) Kanab area. Each position will serve a 4-year term.

Long Valley Sewer Improvement District – (1) One board position open. Applicants must be registered voters of the District, or an officer or employee of the county, or property owners that receive services from the District. Each position will serve a 4-year term.

Western Kane County Special Service District – (3) Three board positions open. Applicants must be registered voters of the District, or an officer or employee of the county, or property owners that receive services from the District. Each position will serve a 4-year term.

Applications will be reviewed by the Commissioner assigned as a liaison to each specific district to make a recommendation for appointment to the full County Commission. New applicants who have not served on the board before will be interviewed by the afore-mentioned commissioner, before a recommendation can be presented to the County Commission for final approval. Currently serving board members will not need to be re-interviewed before being recommended for approval.
