

KANE COUNTY EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. E 2022 – 02

**AN EXECUTIVE ORDER AUTHORIZING AND ORDER OF EVACUATION FOR THE
BRYCE WOODLANDS ESTATES SUBDIVISION DUE TO THE LEFT FORK FIRE**

WHEREAS, on June 21, 2022, under Executive Order No. E 2022-01, the Chief Executive Officer of Kane County Declared a Local State of Emergency due to the Left Fork Fire; and

WHEREAS, the Left Fork Fire has continued to grow and is now threatening mountainous subdivisions in the unincorporated areas of Kane County, including specifically the Bryce Woodlands Estates Subdivision and surrounding areas; and


WHEREAS, an Order of Evacuation of the Bryce Woodlands Estates Subdivision may become necessary as early as this afternoon and the Kane County Sheriff is best suited to trigger the Order of Evacuation when it becomes necessary; and

WHEREAS, the authorization for this executive order is found in Utah Code §53-2a-208, 209, and 205.

NOW THEREFORE, I, ANDREW GANT, CHAIR OF THE KANE COUNTY COMMISSION, STATE OF UTAH, HEREBY ORDER AS FOLLOWS:


1. An Order of Evacuation of the Bryce Woodlands Estates Subdivision in Kane County is hereby authorized and will become effective at the discretion of the Kane County Sheriff, evidenced by his signature below.
2. Once effective, the Order of Evacuation shall require any person to evacuate the Bryce Woodlands Estates Subdivision immediately and to not return until authorized by the Kane County Sheriff.
3. Any person who fails to comply with this Order of Evacuation may be charged with a Class B misdemeanor as set forth in Utah Code §76-8-317.
4. This Executive Order shall be filed promptly with the County Clerk.
