

KANE COUNTY EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. E 2020 – 06

AN EXECUTIVE ORDER CLOSING ALL COUNTY FACILITIES TO BY APPOINTMENT ONLY DUE TO THE EFFECTS OF COVID-19.

WHEREAS, on March 6, Governor Gary Herbert issued an Executive Order declaring a State of Emergency due to infectious disease COVID-19 Novel Coronavirus; and

WHEREAS, on March 18, Lamont Smith issued an Executive Order declaring a local state of emergency due to infectious disease COVID-19 Novel Coronavirus; and

WHEREAS, Kane County remains free from known infections of COVID-19 and remains vigilant of the threat that it poses to the health and safety of the residents of Kane County; and

WHEREAS, Kane County desires to close county facilities to comply with updated recommendations of the State and Federal government guidelines; and

WHEREAS, the authorization for this executive order is found in Utah Code §53-2a-209.

NOW THEREFORE, I, LAMONT SMITH, CHAIR OF THE KANE COUNTY COMMISSION, STATE OF UTAH, HEREBY ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

1. The following Kane County facilities and offices remain closed to the public: Kanab Center, Kane County North Event Center, Kane County Kaneplex, Kane County Search and Rescue (SAR) Building, Kane County Senior Center, Kane County IT Department, HR Department, Budget Office, Roads Department, Kane County Assessor's Office except for services provided by the Division of Motor Vehicles.
2. The Office of Tourism remains a soft closure according to Executive Order 2020-03.
3. All other County Offices are closed to the public except by appointment.
4. This order will be updated as necessary.
